## **DIRECTIONS**

**SITE:** Bloomer Park is located at 345 John R Road. Follow John R north to the park entrance, which is just north of Avon Rd.

**FROM THE EAST:** Take 23 Mile Road West. At Dequindre follow the road to the left. 23 Mile Road will change to Avon Road. Take Avon Rd. to John R Road and turn north (right). Follow John R Rd. to the park entrance.

**Alternate Route:** Take M-59 West to Dequindre north to Avon Rd. Turn left on Avon Rd. Take Avon Rd. to John R Road and turn north (right). Follow John R Rd. to the park entrance. There is no exit on M-59 for John R Road

**FROM THE WEST:** Take 23 Mile Road West. At Dequindre follow the road to the left. 23 Mile Road will change to Avon Road. Take Avon Rd. to John R Road and turn north (right). Follow John R Rd. to the park entrance.

**FROM THE NORTH/SOUTH:** Take Rochester Road to Avon Road and then follow WEST directions above. Or take Van Dyke (M-53) to 23 Mile Rd and follow EAST directions above.

## **ENTRY METHOD – FIRST RECEIVED**

All entries received prior to the April 1, 2009 opening date will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with “no signature required” waiver signed. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours of the opening period

## **ENTRY FEES**

\$25.00 for 1st entry \$13 for each additional entry, each dog, each day.

## **ACCEPTANCE & CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES**

Confirmation Letters and judging schedule will be emailed as soon as possible after closing of the trial.

## **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registerable breed that has obtained a PAL/ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Breeds not registerable with the AKC are NOT eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

## RIBBONS AND PRIZES

- Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score earned.
- Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves: Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each jump height and in each division.
- Preferred Agility and Jumpers with Weaves: Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each jump height and in each division.

## OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

## COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of their class. All walk-throughs are restricted to the handlers entered in that class. **There will be NO contact familiarization for Novice dogs at these trials.**

## MEASURING

All dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official Jump Height Card prior to running in an Agility Trial. All dogs except those jumping 24" or 26"(unless a VMO or AKC Representative is present) without permanent or temporary jump height cards will be measured. **If you have a jump height card, Up N' Over will accept photocopies of the permanent height card or unexpired temporary height card with your entry for this show.**

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between them allowed at the same set of trials.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **Dogs under the age of 6 months are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.**
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Refund of entry fees, less AKC fees and \$5.00 per day administrative fee, will be made for bitches in season or injured dogs upon receipt of letter written by a veterinarian on letterhead stationery prior to that day's event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- **Dogs must be on leash AT ALL TIMES except when in the ring or when in designated agility jump warm-up areas. This will be strictly enforced.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No overnight camping or RV parking is permitted
- **Your help is requested in order to preserve our ability to use our trial site, as well as our motel facilities. We ask for your cooperation in cleaning up after your dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of a refund if the trial committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this regulation. Thank you for your help.**

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. **INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

**Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
